## Information and Digital Technology Statements of Attainment towards Certificate III Information Digital Media and Technology (ICA30111)



Nationally accredited training delivered by the Registered Training Organisation of the Catholic Schools Office (90306).

This course would suit students interested in a career with computers, including hardware, software, information systems and systems support. It provides technical, business, and interpersonal competencies such as installing software applications and networking.

This is an entry level qualification, and students may wish to further their studies post school in Certificate IV Information Technology or a degree through university.

This course can be studied as a 120 hour course in Year 11 or as a 240 hour course over Years 11 & 12. The course is a category B course and may be counted towards the ATAR. Students should note that the HSC examination is optional and is aimed at those interested in gaining university entrance.

The Board of Studies requires students to complete 35 hours of work placement for each 120 hour component of the course. Some schools offer VET courses in Years 9 & 10

This course is competency based and will be assessed using oral, practical, written and other assessment methods.

This course counts towards your HSC, may contribute to your ATAR and is recognised by industry.

It can also count towards a school based part-time traineeship.
