## Entertainment Certificate III Live Production, Theatre and Events (CUE30203)



**Nationally accredited training delivered by the Registered Training Organisation of the Catholic Schools Office (90306).**

**This exciting course provides opportunities in the Entertainment industry with theatre, productions, stage shows and live concerts. Practical aspects of the course cover set building, lighting, and sound as well as entertainment industry knowledge.**

**This course can be studied as a 120 hour course in Year 11 or as a 240 hour course over Years 11 & 12. The course is a category B course and may be counted towards the ATAR. Students should note that the HSC examination is optional and intended for those interested in university entrance. Designed to be an entry level qualification, students may wish to continue their training post school in Certificate IV Live Production, Theatre and Events or a related degree through university.**

**The Board of Studies requires students to complete 35 hours of work placement for each 120 hour component of the course. Some schools offer VET courses in Years 9 & 10**
