Introduction

Mt Erin Boarding House is part of Kildare Catholic College Wagga Wagga, a Year 7-12 co-educational school in the Diocese of Wagga Wagga. Students at Mt Erin Boarding House can also attend Mater Dei Catholic College, located 6 kilometres from the Boarding House. Boarding is weekly, co-educational Years 7-12. Anticipated population for 2018 is 90-100 students.

Role Description

The Leader of Boarding has responsibility for the daily leadership and administration of Mt Erin Boarding House at Kildare Catholic College, working with the College Leadership team to ensure that the Boarding House community is one where each member is welcomed and supported to reach their potential in a setting characterised by a strong and positive Catholic identity.

The Leader of Boarding supports the Diocesan ministry of providing a high quality Catholic education, bringing students to the fullness of their humanity and nurturing high quality relationships, the development of critical thinking capabilities, a hopeful life-view and a nourishing practicing of the Catholic faith.

Along with College leadership, the Leader of Boarding develops an Improvement Plan that focuses on maximising student learning and wellbeing. This includes regular seeking of feedback from students, parents and staff to identify and pursue agreed and shared improvement purposes.

Responsibilities

- The spiritual, academic and wellbeing care of boarders.
- Leading the day-to-day operation of the Boarding House.
- Consistent implementation of College policies and procedures.
- Building productive and respectful relationships with students, parents/carers and staff.
- Maintaining and growing a welcoming, inclusive and safe boarding community and culture.

Selection Criteria

- Clear understanding of the purpose, nature and opportunity of Catholic school boarding.
- Demonstrated high level team-building, communication, leadership and organisational capabilities.
- A growth and improvement mindset, with a demonstrated ability to plan and initiate improvement to improve student learning and wellbeing.
- A highly developed understanding of contemporary teaching, learning, academic care and wellbeing care.

Conditions

- The Leader of Boarding is on-site and leading, from Sunday evening to Friday afternoon each Term week.
- Salary is based on the NSW and ACT Systemic Schools Enterprise Agreement 2015 Teacher Salaries and Allowances Scale with an additional Coordinator 2 allowance.
- A semi-detached 3 bedroom house is provided for the Leader of Boarding.
