Construction Certificate II in Construction Pathways (CPC20211)



Nationally accredited training delivered by the Registered Training Organisation of the Catholic Schools Office (90306).

The course would suit students who are interested in a career in construction, plumbing, electrical trades, plastering, carpentry, concreting or bricklaying. This is an entry level qualification and students may wish to continue their training post school in Certificate III in Carpentry or a degree at university.

This course is a category B course and may be counted towards the ATAR. Students should note that the HSC examination is optional and is intended for those interested in gaining university entrance. This course can be studied as a 120 hour course in Year 11 or as a 240 hour course over Years 11 & 12.

The Board of Studies requires students to complete 35 hours of work placement for each 120 hour component of the course. Some schools offer VET courses in Years 9 & 10

This course is competency based and will be assessed using oral, practical, written and other assessment methods.



This course counts towards your HSC, may contribute to your ATAR and is recognised by industry.

It can also count towards a school based part-time traineeship.
